Armstrong-Spallumcheen Trails Society

1. The name of the Society is Armstrong-Spallumcheen Trails Society.
2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - a) To provide a public amenity by establishing and maintaining public trails and paths in the Armstrong and Spallumcheen areas in British Columbia, for the benefit of the public.
 - b) To protect the environment for the benefit of the public by conserving the natural ecosystems and biodiversity in the area surrounding public trails located in the Armstrong and Spallumcheen areas in British Columbia.
 - c) To advance education by field trips for school groups including instruction on topics related to natural ecosystems surrounding the trails in the Armstrong and Spallumcheen areas.
 - d) To do all such things as are incidental and ancillary to the attainment of the above charitable purposes.
3. The bylaws of the Society are those set out in Schedule B of the Society Act.
